We have both a Facebook and Instagram page where we post pictures of all of our puppies and adults. Kristie's Husky Haven is the name of our pages. We try to be active and up to date on Instagram but we are much better on our Facebook page. Both of these pages are an easy way to stay in touch and see any photos we may post. We also would like for you to post on there and share your puppy with us there. It is also an open line of communication for you to get in touch with me at any point should you have any questions or need any help. Being added there is a requirement when getting one of our puppies. We also require monthly updates/ photos and vet records of the puppies for the 1st year they are with you. After a year of age we require updates every 6 months including photographs. If you do not have a Facebook or Instagram then you are required to fulfill these requirements via email or text message. Deposit Policy:

If your application is approved and place a deposit, you are committing to taking a puppy from the litter mentioned on the application and agreed upon with the breeder, regardless of whether your gender/color preference is available. Should you elect to not take a puppy from the litter, your deposit is still valid for 2 more litters of equal comparison. If you place a deposit on a puppy and that puppy passes away, you can use your deposit toward another puppy of your choice from the same litter, or on any current or future litters within the next 2 available litters of same or equal value. Deposits are non-refundable and all sales are final. Your deposit is only valid for 3 litters total including the one you originally placed your deposit on. If you decide you do not want to get a puppy anymore, you forfeit your deposit.

If we feel like your family and your home is a good fit then we will let you know and you may place a \$250 non-refundable deposit. The deposit is required to hold the puppy of your choice or to hold a spot on the pick of the litter list to hold your spot in line and will then hold the puppy you choose once it's your time to choose. The remaining amount due must be placed by the time you pick up your puppy.

From time to time we may decide to keep a puppy out of a litter. We reserve the right to hold puppies. This may mean that certain puppies may not be available for a couple weeks while we decide on if we may keep the said puppy.

Puppies will go to their new homes at 8 weeks. We do not like to hold puppies for extended periods of time; it is critical for their social development that the litter departs within a reasonable timeframe. Puppies must be picked up within 7 days unless other written arrangements are made. If the puppy has not been picked up within this time frame and we have not agreed to another day after the 7 days or have not heard from you after the 7 days, you then forfeit your deposit and your hold on the puppy. We will then offer the puppy to the next approved family. If the puppy is not paid in full at time of picking up your puppy, then your deposit is forfeited and we will find the said puppy a new and approved home. We are able to hold a puppy for a little longer if the family is not able to bring home the puppy at 8 weeks old. We will hold the puppy for up to a week after the turn of 8 weeks old at no cost. After a week we do charge a boarding, feed, and puppy training fee of \$8 a day or \$50 per week along with any costs for de-wormer or puppy vaccine updates if those need to be done while in our care.

We have a contract and will not place a puppy without a signed contract. We believe it's the professional thing to do to memorialize our obligations to each other on paper so there are no questions later. If you have any questions about specific terms, you need to contact us prior to picking up your puppy.
